

# Volunteer Guidelines and Waiver for Molalla Buckeroo Rodeo

As a volunteer at the Molalla kick-off and Buckeroo Rodeo, one must acknowledge and declare their voluntary participation in the program. It is essential to understand the following guidelines and agreements:

- **Risk Acknowledgement:** While volunteering involves risks, the Molalla Buckeroo Rodeo Association is released from liability. Volunteers release the Rodeo and its affiliates from any injury or property damage claims during their participation.
- **Medical Assistance:** Volunteers are responsible for any medical costs incurred during their service. They consent to Rodeo Staff arranging first aid or ambulance services if needed and agree to follow guidelines provided by the Molalla Buckeroo.
- **Equipment and Transportation:** Volunteers must be certified to use fair-owned equipment. Personal vehicles should be used for travel to and from volunteer locations. Driving fair-owned vehicles is prohibited.
- **Volunteer Status:** Volunteers serve gratuitously and privately, not as employees, agents, or contractors of the fair.
- **Duties and Hours:** Volunteers must specify their duties and hours served at the Molalla Kick-off and Buckeroo Rodeo. Advanced notice is required if scheduled and unable to volunteer.

As a parent or guardian of a volunteer under 18 years old, it is required to review and sign the statement on their behalf, accepting the guidelines, including the consent to medical assistance and release from liability.
